Crisis Prevention and Management:

Crisis Text Lines:

• 988 (call, text, chat) National Suicide Prevention Lifeline (https://988lifeline.org/) has been designated as the new three-digit dialing code that will route callers to the National Suicide Prevention Lifeline (now known as the 988 Suicide & Crisis Lifeline), and is now active across the United States. When people call, text, or chat 988, they will be connected to trained counselors that are part of the existing Lifeline network. These trained counselors will listen, understand how their problems are affecting them, provide support, and connect them to resources if necessary.

REACH is a crisis prevention, intervention and stabilization system to support individuals with intellectual and/or developmental disabilities, as well as a mental health condition or challenging behavior that is negatively affecting their quality of life. http://www.rbha.org

CREST is a resource for youth who in Region 4 ages 5 – 18 who are in crisis and need help. CREST clinicians work with family to triage and problem-solve the crisis at-hand; identify ongoing treatment needs; link to outside providers; and provide community-based counseling.

Chippenham Hospital - Tucker Adolescent Partial Hospitalization Program (PHP) if over 12 7101 Jahnke Rd. Richmond, VA 23225

- Call **804-521-8975** for direct referral for partial program
- PHP involves meeting w/ a psychiatrist 2x a week and daily intensive mental health support working in individual and group therapy
- Usually can get in the same day or the next day

Poplar Springs Hospital Adolescents Acute Inpatient Program for ages 11 – 17 No-cost assessments are offered 24/7 @ 804.733.6874 or 1-866-546-2229

Walk in mental health services at their local Community Service Board (CSB) ALL should have daily same day access clinic
